Re: City of Marco Island Firefighters Pension Plan

Dear Toby:

As requested, we have reviewed the proposed ordinance which would amend City of Marco Island Firefighters Pension Plan as follows:

• Amend Section 22-55, Finances and Fund Management, to allow the Board of Trustees to invest the fund as they deem advisable including an allocation of up to 80% of the fund value in stocks with up to 25% in foreign securities, in accordance with the investment procedures of the Florida Statutes.

In our opinion, these changes will not have an actuarial impact on the cost of the Retirement System for prefunding purposes. It is our opinion that a formal Actuarial Impact Statement is not required. However, we recommend that you send a copy of this letter and the ordinance to the Bureau of Local Retirement Systems.
