



City Manager – City Council Report August 17, 2026

Team Wins: Wins for the City Council, staff, our residents and the environment!

1. Public Works has filled two project manager vacancies. One project manager has already secured a grant reimbursement from FDEP for approximately \$300,000 for a swale exfiltration project.
2. I participated in a GovLove podcast on August 7th for local government leaders highlighting career opportunities in local government.
3. I am meeting with leadership from Audubon Western Everglades on August 21st to discuss areas of collaboration with the City.

General Updates for the Council and Public:

1. Public Works has submitted a 4e Alternate Water Quality Plan Update to FDEP. It is currently under review by FDEP. It was also sent to City Council for informational purposes. Once finalized and approved by FDEP, it will be posted to the City's website.
2. The public is invited to attend a September 11th recognition ceremony in front of the Fire Station, located behind City Hall, on September 11th at 9:30am.
3. Members of City leadership participated in a rating call with Moody's on August 3rd. When we receive the credit rating, Moody's will send a press release which we will post on the City website.
