

RESOLUTION 19-33

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; MAKING FINDINGS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation and the City of Marco Island desire to facilitate the construction of the North Collier Boulevard Sidewalk Project; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has requested that the City of Marco Island, Florida, execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation a Local Agency Program Agreement for the contemplated project to effectuate a Local Agency Program status by the City for oversight and management of construction projects financed by future state and federal funds. The City contributed \$188,426.00 from the FY 2018 budget for the survey and design of this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing findings are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The City Council hereby ratifies the City's subsequent entry into a Local Agency Program Agreement. The City Manager is hereby directed and authorized to execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation a Local Agency Program Agreement for the aforementioned contemplated projects upon presentation of said Agreement by staff.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
