RESOLUTION 19-43

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, CREATING THE WATERWAYS ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE CITY COUNCIL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Marco Island provides for continuous citizen input and advice through a wide variety of boards and committees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is in the best interest of the community to create a Waterways Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council will appoint members to the committee that have substantial experience in areas that would be beneficial in carrying out the purposes of the committee and have the ability to devote the time necessary to the business of the committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- Section 2. The Marco Island City Council hereby creates the Waterways Advisory Committee, consisting of seven (7) members chosen by City Council whose terms will be established in accordance with Sec. 2-204 of the Code of Ordinances.
- **Section 3.** The Waterways Advisory Committee shall be responsible for providing recommendations to the City Council regarding:
 - 1. Water quality issues
 - 2. Safe boating and navigation issues
 - 3. Seawall and boat dock issues
 - 4. Public awareness and education efforts

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
