Capital Expenditures:

City Council authorized \$131,800 for police vehicle replacements in the FY15 Capital Improvements Program. The Department intends to purchase two (2) 2015 Ford Interceptor Utility V6 AWD vehicles including ancillary equipment (safety, emergency, video and communications). Vehicle price (\$25,376 per unit) is based on the 2014 / 2015 Florida Sheriff's Association cooperative purchasing contract (14-22-0904). Ancillary equipment (\$53,248 total) will be acquired through various government contracts or competitive bidding - per City ordinance.
