The following activities were conducted by the Street and Drainage Staff:

- Swept bike lanes Citywide.
- Grind uneven sidewalk panels on Collier Blvd.
- Replaced failed storm pipe Magnolia at Bald Eagle Dr.
- Cleaning storm drains N. Barfield Dr.
- Pressure cleaned Bridge 36002 Barfield Dr. over Marco River Inlet.
- Picked up roadkill on Collier Blvd.
- Repaired pothole on Collier Blvd at Amazon
- Cleaned up trash spill on Bald Eagle Dr.
- Camera storm drain on 855 Banyan.
- Camera storm drain on 824 Giralda Ct.
- Straighten Signs
- Replaced wood street sign poles with metal poles.
- Picked up trash scattered down Wells Sawyer way
- Grind uneven sidewalks on Winterberry Dr.
- Repaired uneven sidewalk panels on Collier Boulevard.
- Camera 1180 Samoa Av. Storm Drain.
- Repaired Catch Basin Grate on Bayside Ave.
- Repair pothole South Barfield.
- Install 57 stone at seawall with outfall.
- Replaced Navigation light that was hit by a boat at the West Winterberry Bridge.
- Repaired Navigation light East Winterberry Bridge.
- Cleaned storm grates after heavy storm.
- Repaired Traffic Signal Camera at Elkcam Cir. And Collier Blvd.
- Picked up excessive trash at Jolley Bridge.
- Relocate sign for visibility.
- Repair walkway on Herb Savage Bridge.

- Install body bushings on Bucket Lift Truck.
- Remove Brush at Jolley Bridge.
- Install 2 more trash cans at Jolley Bridge.
- Change out faded speed limit sign N. Barfield.
- Grind uneven sidewalks around City Hall.
- Picked up roadkill on Kendall.
- Changed out engine coil packs in PW-02.
- Repairing retaining wall on Herb Savage Bridge.
- New Issued Right of Way Permits 57
- Right of Way Inspections 143

The following activities were completed by Stormwater Engineer:

- Eight (8) Commercial Right of Way Permit applications approved and issued.
- Two (2) Site Development Plan applications reviewed for compliance.
- One (1) Building Permit application reviewed for compliance.
- Erosion and sediment control inspections/site visits weekly (on going).
- Municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) compliance/reporting/record keeping (on going).
- MS4 Notice of Intent (NOI) Cycle 2 approved.
- Investigations of MS4 related violations, complaints, calls, etc. (on going)
- Waterways Advisory Committee meeting.
- Single-family construction - erosion and sediment control plan permitting requirements.
- Community Rating System (CRS) code revisions/additions for stormwater management.
- Community Rating System (CRS) maintenance plan for stormwater infrastructure.
- MS4 (on going).

The following is a status update of various Public Works Projects:

- Yellowbird Roadway/Utility Project – Final Paving operation to begin May 10th.
- Yellowbird Roadway/Utility Project – 97% Complete Final acceptance tentatively on May 20th.
- W. Winterberry Bridge Design – 90% complete Plans due to the Public Works Director on April 26th.
- Sidewalk Construction – Received final acceptance of bids by FDOT for Inlet Drive and Bald Eagle Drive Sidewalk Projects. Opening bids for the San Marco Sidewalk from Vintage Bay to Goodland Road on April 22nd.
- Veterans' Community Park – 90% CD Estimate to be submitted to City Council on April 19th.
- Advertising for the Annual Roadway Resurfacing Project for 2021 on April 1st.
