Award Contracts to 14 Firms for Coastal Engineering, Surveying Services, and Water Quality Related Engineering Services on an As-Needed Basis (RFQ 2023-009) - Justin Martin, Director, Public Works

### BACKGROUND:

In accordance with Florida Statutes, Chapter 287.055, Consultants Competitive Negotiations Act (CCNA), on January 3, 2023, the City of Marco Island published a request for qualifications (RFQ 2023-009) from Florida certified, licensed, and experienced engineering firms to assist the City with various subsurface utility engineering (no proposals received), surveying, water quality (new category), and coastal engineering projects. The last category is primarily utilized for the Hideaway Beach Special Taxing District projects. These will be continuing service contracts for the initial three-year term with a possibility of an additional one three-year extension. The current contract (#17-005) for these services was awarded in 2017 and its six-year term will expire on February 28, 2023.

As limited by the CCNA, work awarded under these contracts will be for projects in which the estimated construction cost of each individual project does not exceed \$4 million, or for study activity where the fee for each individual study does not exceed \$500,000.

A total of 1,502 suppliers were notified of this solicitation, 68 obtained the solicitation documents, and 14 responded. Submittals have been subsequently reviewed and recommendation has been made to award contracts to the firms as outlined below.
