General Updates for the Council and Public:

1. Clean Marco Waters LLC submitted a petition to FDEP on March 2nd regarding possible impairment in the Tigertail Lagoon. We are awaiting a formal response from FDEP.
2. The City received a letter from FDOT outlining deficiencies found during their inspection of the Caxambas Bridge. The letter required “prompt corrective action” and rated the structure in a “serious” condition. At the March 3 City Council meeting a majority of Councilors agreed to replace the Caxambas Bridge.
