

RESOLUTION 26-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA, IMPLEMENTING A VEHICLE REGISTRATION SYSTEM FOR PARKING NON-COMMERCIAL VEHICLES ON SWALES IN RESIDENTIALLY ZONED DISTRICTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Marco Island ("City") adopted Ordinance 26-01, (the "Ordinance") which provides for a vehicle registration process that will permit occupants of residentially zoned property to park one non-commercial vehicle in the swale adjacent to their property between the hours of 2am and 6am from January 16th through November 14th; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ordinance, the City Council is required to adopt a process for the public to register vehicles in conformance with the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is necessary and in the best interest of the public's health, safety, and welfare to adopt the rules and regulations to implement the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING BOARD OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. That the City of Marco Island City Council hereby adopts the non-commercial vehicle swale parking permit requirements, as follows:

Non-Commercial Vehicle Swale Parking Permits shall only be issued to Marco Island residents, for the purposes of parking a non-commercial vehicle between the hours of 2am to 6am during the time period from January 16th to November 14th. The resident's address and the address on the vehicle's registration must be for the same residential property located in Marco Island. The permit authorizes the resident to park the vehicle in the swale at the resident's address. The fee for the permit shall be One Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$100.00).

SECTION 3. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
