RESOLUTION 19-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND, FLORIDA APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS HANDBOOK FOR WORK WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has amended Chapter 42, Sections 42-33 and 42-75 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Marco Island for the purpose of adopting the Construction Standards Handbook for Work Within the Public Right-of-Way; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to supplement and revise the standards set forth in the City of Marco Island Construction Standards Handbook for Work Within the Public Right-of-Way to be more responsive to the local conditions in the City of Marco Island; and

WHEREAS, approved amendments to Chapter 42, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Marco Island require amendments to the Construction Standards Handbook for Work Within the Public Right-of-Way; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of amendments to the City of Marco Island Construction Standards Handbook for Work Within the Public Right-Of-Way, is considered to be in the best interest of public safety and the protection of public facilities within the public rights-of-way in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida that:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, correct, and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Amendment. The amendments to the City of Marco Island Construction Standards Handbook for Work Within the Public Right-of-Way are hereby approved as follows:

1. Section 13: Sod & Approved Groundcover Species Placement is hereby amended as follows:

Paragraph 1. (A), add the following approved ground cover: Frog Fruit (Phyla nodiflora).

Paragraph 1. (D), add the following approved ground cover: Frog Fruit (Phyla nodiflora).

Paragraph 1. Add the following subparagraph (J): Planting in the swale areas around mailboxes shall be allowed with the stipulation that nine square feet (9 SF, no larger than 3-ft by 3-ft) of the area be maintained no taller than 36-inches. No permit required.

Section 3. Adoption. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
