City Manager's Office:

- Assistant City Manager concluded interviews for HR Director, made an offer to the top candidate. The new Director will start on October 6, 20225.
- Assistant City Manager conducted Fire Union negotiations with the Fire Chief and representatives from IAFF Local 2887.
- Participated in the Water Quality Workshop and presented Operating budget for FY26 in the budget workshop.
- Distributed August Newsletter to 8,947 residents via new website; newsletter was opened by 2,561 residents.
- 5 press releases were sent from the City Manager's Office in July.
- 56 social media posts were posted from the City Manager's Office.
- 14 app notifications were sent using the new Marco Island App and Live Feed webpage.

- 1. Efficiency in our Purchasing Program
 - Purchasing Manager worked with the Police Department and City attorney to create a contract with Motorola. This contract will be used to purchase in vehicle camera equipment. This contract was procured by piggybacking off of a competitively bid contract through Sourcewell.
 - Purchasing Manager attended Florida Procurement Training regarding Cooperative Purchasing, Emergency & Disaster Procurement Readiness and Managing Vendor Performance Contract Compliance.
 - Purchasing Manager conducted one-on-one contract training with Fire Department Administrative Assistant.

Purchase orders:

53 purchase orders were issued in July 2025 in the amount of \$796,066. Fiscal Year-to-date we have issued 726 Purchase Orders for \$19,959,875. Last fiscal year-to-date we issued 722 Purchase Orders for \$19,963,408. This is an increase in volume of less than one percent and a decrease of about 1.7% in terms of encumbered dollars.

In July 2025 we issued purchase orders in the following thresholds:

- 24 for the amounts less than \$5,000
- 7 for the amounts between \$5,000 and \$9,999
- 22 for the amounts \$10,000 and above






Online Video Streaming Site Visitor Statistics – Period: July, 2025







