Mr. Woodworth,

Thank you again for meeting with us to discuss your concerns and those of the Water Advisory Committee. We appreciate the time and effort that you and the committee have dedicated to this matter.

After reviewing the materials you circulated, I wanted to provide a few clarifications for the benefit of the committee. While the responses in red reflect your understanding and interpretation of the discussion, they should not be viewed as official written responses from staff.

For example, regarding canal patrols for ordinance violations, staff advised during the meeting that Code Enforcement conducts routine land-based patrols and that the Marine Unit regularly patrols the waterways and has the ability to enforce applicable ordinance violations.

Additionally, the attached staffing and funding memo appears to represent your independently prepared position paper. While portions of the document were discussed generally during the meeting, staff has not conducted a comprehensive review or verification of the information contained within it.

We appreciate the committee's continued interest and involvement and simply want to ensure there is a clear distinction between independently prepared committee member materials and official staff-reviewed or staff-supported work product.
