AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND AMENDING SECTION 30-526, "SIGNS IN COMMERCIAL, PUBLIC USE AND COMMUNITY FACILITY DISTRICTS," OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND CODE OF ORDINANCES, TO ALLOW FOR GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SIGNS WITH A COMBINED ELECTRONIC FACE NOT TO EXCEED 48 SQUARE FEET IN PUBLIC USE ZONING DISTRICTS AND IN PUBLIC AREAS; AMENDING SECTION 30-530, "DEFINITIONS," OF THE CITY OF MARCO ISLAND CODE OF ORDINANCES TO INCLUDE A DEFINITION FOR "GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The applicant, the City of Marco Island, is requesting a text change to the city's sign code, which is part of the City's Land Development Code, allowing for the use of government information signs. This change would allow the city to communicate information to the public about things such as programs, events, laws, notices, and any other similar content. It is also adding the definition for a "government information sign".
