


































CFR title 38: Service by the American Merchant Marine in oceangoing service during armed conflict 1941 to 1945 <u>as</u> <u>active duty in WWII</u>

Dept. of Veterans Affairs M21-1 Merchant Service in WWII: Eligible for benefits in the <u>same manner as any other</u>

<u>Veteran</u> including discharge certificates (DD214). <u>Deemed active duty</u> for burial benefits. (Arlington).

A 101 y/o Merchant Marine Veteran: "say to them what we did; urge them to read about us and find out about us. We gave up our yesterdays for your better tomorrow."
