Review of the Effect of the Gulf Loop Current on Marco Island Waterways

The purpose of this white paper is to bring to the attention of the City Council and

the Citizens of Marco Island the existence of the Gulf Loop Current and its

potential impact on water quality on Marco Island. The Gulf Loop Current is the

driving force behind the movement of water throughout the Gulf of Mexico and

beyond. However, this current is not constant in its course or velocity. Changes in

the current occur over short intervals, measured in days, as well as over long

intervals, measured in years and decades. Because Marco Island is near the end

point of a land mass that shapes this current, its effects on the waters around Marco

Island can be dramatic.

This presentation will describe the current and invite the community to be aware of

and involved in reporting evidence of this current and it's possible influence on our

water quality.
