## A Proclamation Recognizing Stevens Johnson Syndrome Awareness Month

**WHEREAS,** Stevens Johnson Syndrome (SJS) and Toxic Epidermal Necrolysis, another form of SJS, are severe adverse reactions to medication.

SJS is one of the most debilitating conditions recognized; and

WHEREAS, SJS was discovered in 1922 and almost any medication, including

over-the-counter drugs, can cause SJS; and

**WHEREAS,** SJS affects people of all ages and a large amount of its victims are

children; and

WHEREAS, according to the New England Journal of Medicine, over 2 million

Americans fall ill and are hospitalized every year from taking these recommended drugs, and of that 2 million that are admitted, over

140,000 are never released; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the early symptoms of SJS and prompt medical

attention are the most invaluable tools in minimizing the possible

long-term effects that SJS may have on its victims; and

WHEREAS, the individuals affected with SJS and their families, friends, and

caregivers are recognized; and

**WHEREAS,** the health and safety of our citizens is of utmost importance and the

City of Marco Island is committed to raising awareness and supporting efforts to minimize the effects of life-threatening diseases

such as Stevens Johnson Syndrome.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it proclaimed by the City Council of the City of Marco Island, Florida, the month of August, 2019 is hereby recognized as Stevens Johnson Syndrome Awareness Month.
