

Funding Request Approved

At the July 17, 2019 Beach and Coastal Resources Advisory Committee meeting, the committee voted to **fund from their FY19 budget**, the following items for the Owl Watch Program of Marco Island, managed by the Audubon of the Western Everglades (AWE):

Description:

1) Help subsidize Owl Watch Biologist research/banding/DNA Testing	\$900
2) Supplies: Owl bands, blood vials, needles, pvc pipes, perches	\$500
3) Supplies: Weed wacking burrows, wacker/line roll	\$900
4) Marco shorebird anchor steward – 4 months	\$400
5) AWE/Code Enforcement outreach program campaign for listed species	\$300
Ordinance and Fertilizer Ord.

6) Launch gopher tortoise field study and survey report initiative to be performed by AWE	<u>\$1,500.00</u>
