-- Water Quality Monitoring Program

-- Point Source Control

> Fertilizer application control/guidelines

> Role of swales

> On-site water retention

-- Boater discharge prohibition

> Pump out facility availability designating which ones are free

-- Discarding of debris

-- Other code enforcement issues

It would also be helpful if you could identify information currently on the City website from other sources which would provide input to filling out the categories above

For example, the Safe Boating Brochure contains information on pump out facilities
