## Phase 2 MS4 Generic Permit

#### **The PURPOSE:**

- To develop, implement and enforce a *Stormwater Management Program*
- To reduce discharge of pollutants
- To protect water quality
- To satisfy water quality requirements of the Clean Water Act.

# MS4

## What is a MS4?

- <u>Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System</u>
- <u>Municipal</u> System owned or operated by a public agency
- <u>Separate</u> Does not connect to the sanitary sewer system and does not lead to a wastewater treatment plant
- <u>Storm Sewer System</u> A system of publicly owned conveyance(s) and includes roads, curbs, gutters, catch basins, swales, or ditches that discharge to surface waters of the state (outfalls), and is designed or used solely for collecting or conveying stormwater

- 1. Public Education & Outreach as to Stormwater Impacts
- 2. Public Involvement/Public Participation
- 3. Illicit Discharge Detection & Elimination
- 4. Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control
- 5. Post-Construction Stormwater Management in New Development & Re-Development
- 6. Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping for Municipal Operations
