UPDATED 90% CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENT DEVELOPMENT

Manhattan has produced an estimate summary for the scope of work included in the Updated 90% Construction Documents. This includes subcontractor scoped pricing for the bid packages noted based on a solicitation process. The Updated 90% Construction Document Estimate Summary does not include any type of design contingency and this updated estimate summary assumes an 11-month construction schedule with an additional month for closeout.

ALLOWANCES

The updated estimate summary includes certain elements of the work that are not sufficiently defined to either completely acquire cost opinions from vendors and therefore allowances are used as reasonable placeholder values in the budget update. For the MIVP project, the use of allowances for this deliverable are noted on page 7 of the clarifications and are valued at \$87,000.

CONTINGENCIES

This updated estimate summary includes a 3% construction managers contingency.

VALUE MANAGEMENT

Manhattan and the design professionals conducted several value management work sessions between February, March and April and developed a list of accepted costs saving options valued at \$435,447 that represents a Revised Updated 90% CD Budget at \$10,618,597. Additional pending costs saving valued at \$901,134 can potentially bring the Revised Updated 90% CD Budget to a total that includes Accepted and Pending Value Management Items at \$9,717,463.

SCHEDULE

A preliminary schedule has been developed by the construction team that will build the project. The budget aligns with the 11-month schedule for construction and 1-month for closeout.

SITE MANAGEMENT AND PHASING

The site management represents the closing of the entire park for the full duration of the project.




