- Route 121 - Morning & afternoon express route providing service between Immokalee & Marco Island



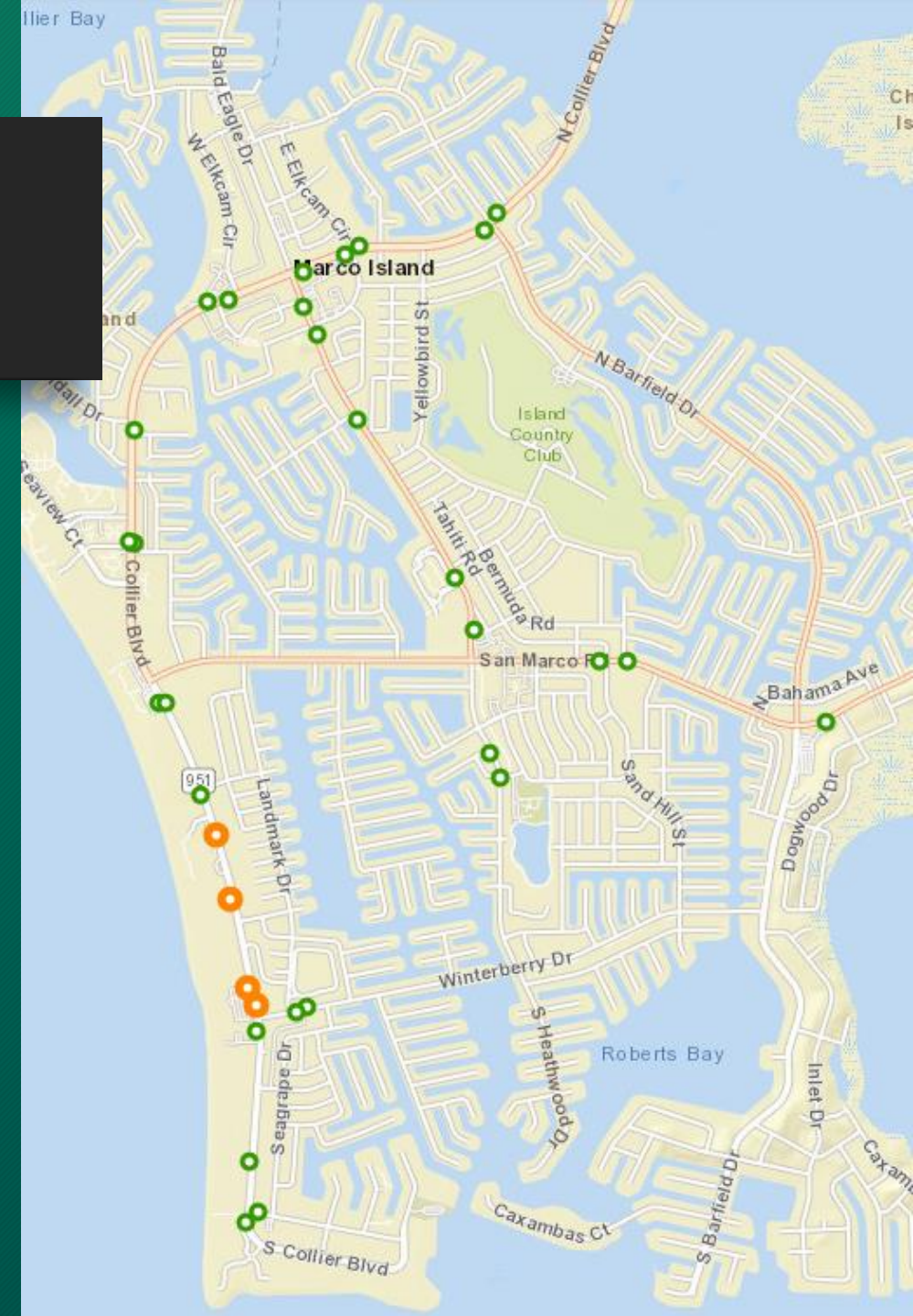

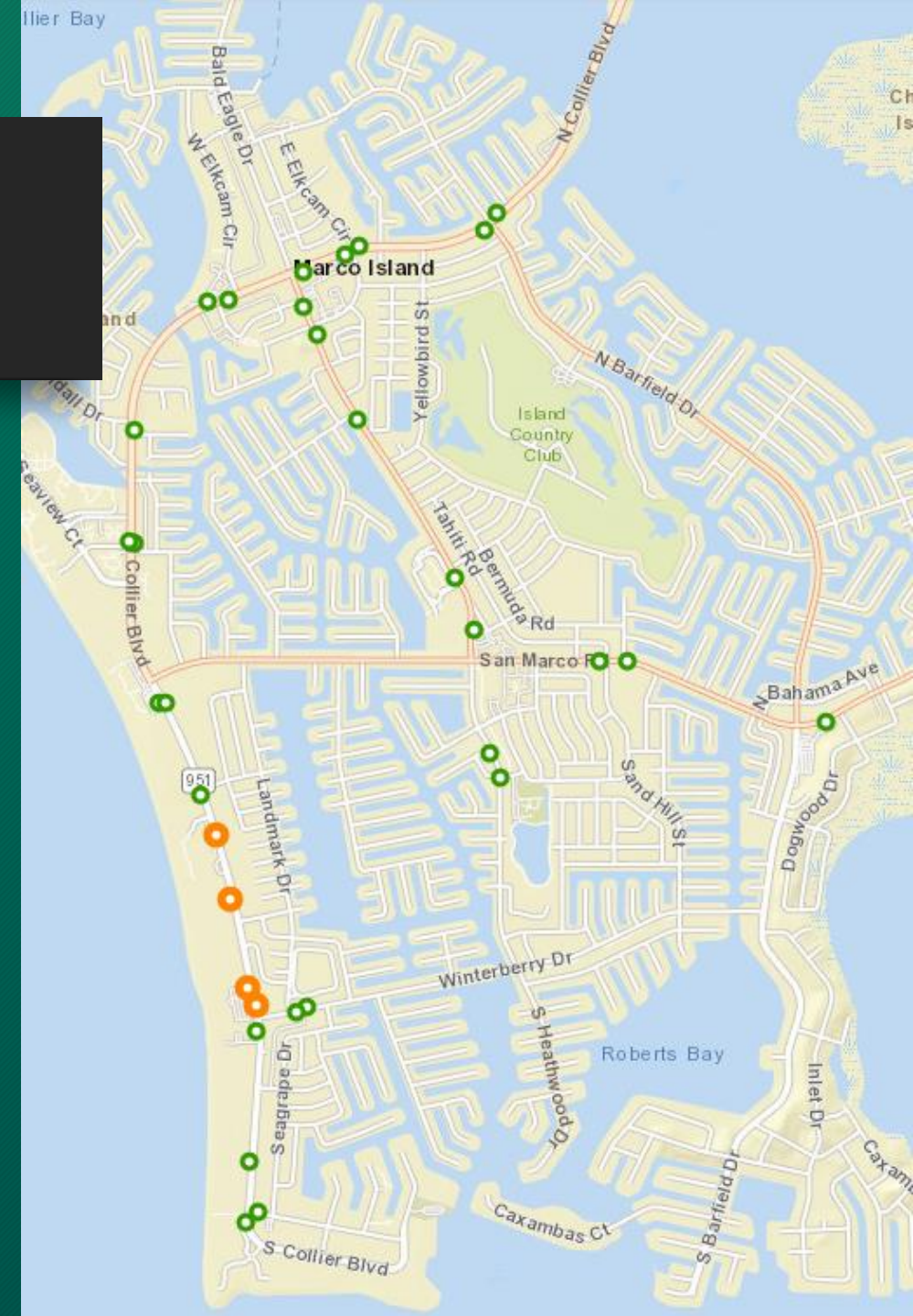
Route 21

- Operates 7 Days a week
 - 7:40 am - 10:50 am and 2:50 pm to 4:50 pm
- Primary Inbound Stops - Oct 1st, 2020 to Sept 30th, 2021
 - Walmart Collier Blvd & US41 (7,971 Passengers)
 - Towne Center at Elkcarn (1,410 Passengers)
- Primary Outbound Stops - Oct 1st, 2020 to Sept 30th, 2021
 - Town Center at Elkcarn (1,609 Passengers)
 - South Marco Access (1,356 Passengers)
 - Marco Marriot & Hilton (1, 652 Passengers)



Route 121

- Operates 7 Days a week
- 2 trips- 5:30 AM and 4:50 PM
- Passenger Per Rev Hour 16.8
- Primary Pick-Ups:
 - 951 / US41 (3,555 - Annual Boarding)
 - Lake Trafford Rd, Immokalee (2,864 - Annual Boarding)
- Primary Drop-Offs
 - Marco Island Marriott (4,399 - Annual Alighting)
 - Marco Island Hilton (4,015 - Annual Alighting)



Proposed Future Service for Marco Island

- Trolley Service:
 - A route that would circulate on the island.
 - Envision using 2 vehicles that would be a hop-on/hop-off type of service.
 - Provide service to busy corridors and help mitigate the need to drive and help reduce congestion and parking demand.
 - The service will have routing flexibility based on time of day.



Pilot Marco Island Trolley

- Pilot scheduled Dec 4th & 5th
- Fixed-route traveling in a loop around Marco Island, stopping at destinations throughout the island.
- Hop-on/Hop-off service during the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.
- Partnership with Blue Zones & Chamber of Commerce.
