# White Paper Advisory Committees Update: Follow Up

## Initial White Paper Presentation to the City Council Identified Five Areas of Concern Regarding Advisory Committees:

- Lack of standardization of the structure and language used in the Resolutions creating the Advisory Committees.
- Lack of specificity regarding oversight of Advisory Committees.
- Lack of annual goal setting and work plans with action steps (objectives).
- Lack of clarification regarding funding, fund raising, and budgeting.
- Lack of specificity regarding number of meetings.

## The City Council Supported:

- Creating a new Template that standardizes the structure and language used in the Advisory Committee Resolutions.
- Codifying a mechanism for funding, fund raising, and budgeting.
- Standardizing the goal setting and work plan development process while allowing for flexibility and autonomy for committees.

## The City Council Rejected:

Specifying the frequency of Advisory Committee Meetings.

## The City Council was Ambivalent About:

Having more direct oversight of Advisory Committees.

## **Follow-Up Course of Action**

I took the following course of action to revise the three issues supported by the City Council:

## **Created a Standardized Advisory Council Resolution Template**

- Reviewed all of the original Resolutions that created the four Advisory Committees
  (the Ad Hoc Bike Path Committee did not have a resolution creating it).
- Created a standardized Advisory Committee Resolution Template by integrating the four common elements from the Resolutions already in use.
- Added additional elements related to funding and the creation of Goals and Annual Work Plans.

# Added Language that Codifies Funding Mechanisms, Fund Raising, and Budgeting

 Added an additional element that standardizes and clarifies budgeting, funding, and fund-raising for all Advisory Committees.

## Standardized a Flexible Goal Setting and Work Plan Format

- Copied the goals and action items from each existing Advisory Committee Resolution.
- Separated the goals from the action items.
- Plugged the Goals and Action Items into Sample Annual Work Plans.

## **Obtained Feedback From Committee Members**

- Sent the sample Standardized Advisory Committee Template via email to all committee members.
- Sent sample 2014 Goals and Work Plans for the different Advisory Committees via email to committee members.
- Asked the committee members for their personal feedback.
- Advised committee members to reply to me to avoid any Sunshine Law conflicts.
- Explained that I would follow-up with their Advisory Committees following City Council Approval.

By the end of 2024 Beach and Coastal Advisory Committee will:

**Goal 1: Protecting Sea Turtles.** 

 Action Step: Conduct public education/information programs with condominium boards and associations along Collier Blvd, local service clubs and organizations, and schools on the island related to the Sea Turtle Lighting Ordinance.

## Goal 2: Protecting Burrowing Owls, Gopher Tortoises and protected species on Marco Island.

- Action Step: Conduct public education/information programs on listed species identified in the City of Marco Island's Protected Species Ordinance.
- Action Step: Work with the City Council to develop and enforce programs that protect listed species identified in the City's Protected Species Ordinance.
- Action Step: Obtain funding from the City Council to continue the AWE Gopher Tortoise study.

## Sample Beach and Coastal Advisory Committee Workplan

By the end of 2024 Beach and Coastal Advisory Committee will:

## Goal 3: Protecting the Big Marco Pass Critical Wildlife Area.

 Action Step: Use the support of Audubon Western Everglades, Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission, Rookery Bay, and the Conservancy to develop plans to protect the area and other critical wildlife areas on Marco Island.

## **Sample Charges/Mission Statements**

**The Beach and Coastal Resources Advisory Committee** is charged with identifying short and long-term issues that impact the beach and coastal environment, evaluating potential solutions and recommending policy and practices to City staff for administrative or Council action.

The Waterways Advisory Committee is charged with identifying short and long-term issues that impact water quality, safe boating and navigation, and seawalls and docks, evaluating potential solutions and recommending policy and practices to City staff for administrative or Council action.

The Beautification Advisory Committee is charged with identifying short and long-term issues that impact the overall beauty and appeal of the island including planted street medians and streetscapes, publicly-owned cul-de-sacs, beach access points, evaluating potential solutions and recommending policy and practices to City staff for administrative or Council action.

## **Sample Charges/Mission Statements**

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee is charged with identifying short and long-term issues that impact parks and recreational facilities, and passive and active recreational activities, services, and programs, evaluating potential solutions and recommending policy and practices to City staff for administrative or Council action.

The Bike Path Advisory Committee is charged with identifying short and long-term issues that impact safe and convenient bicycle access to all parts of Marco Island, safe integration of motorized bikes and scooters on city streets and bike paths, and the expansion of bike-related recreational activities, evaluating potential solutions and recommending policy and practices to City staff for administrative or Council action.

- Motion to accept the standardized Advisory Committee Resolution Template.
- Motion to create a new Bike Path Advisory Committee.
- Grant permission to meet with the Individual Advisory Committees and their City Liaisons to clarify their goals and develop their Annual Workplans.
